What a great turn out we had for our Christmas gathering at Waverley Bowls on 9th December.

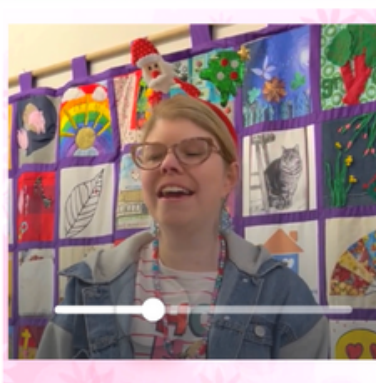
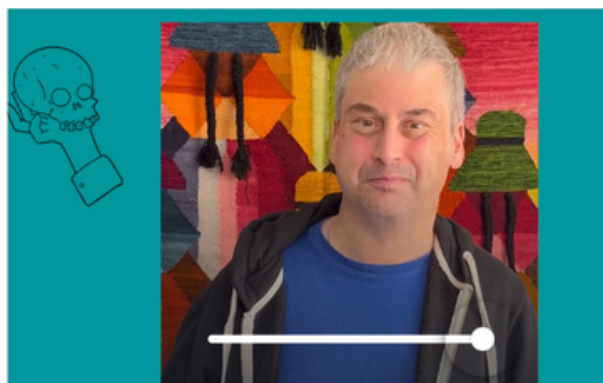
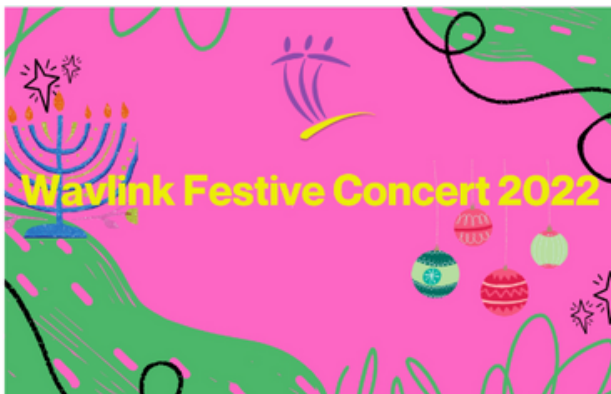
