

Enrollment eligibility


Wavlink is funded by the Neighbourhood House Coordination Program (NHCP) the Home and Community Care Program for younger persons (HACC PYP) and is a registered National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) provider. We also receive non recurrent grant funding to deliver various community activities for the wider community including carers, volunteers and local Monash residents.

Wavlink provides core level supports to people with moderate needs for assistance that are able to attend independently and participate in group activities at a 1:5 ratio. We can not offer complex or personal care, management of medication. or support for people with behaviors that require a 1:1 ratio.


